



Town Hall Closed Until Further Notice

Effective starting at 3 p.m. on March 17, 2020, The Village of Silverton will be closing its administrative offices. This temporary closure is deemed necessary to minimize social contact in light of the Corona Virus pandemic. No specific date has been set for offices to reopen as the response to the Corona Virus is rapidly evolving.

- To the extent practical—and until state or federal officials order a general quarantine—Village employees will still be working and answering calls for service.

- Trash and recycling services are not changed at this time. Collections should occur on your street's normal day of the week.
- Residents are asked to not put out brush for weekly (on Wednesday) brush collections for the rest of March.
