# INTRODUCTION AND READING OF NEW AND/OR PENDING LEGISLATION:

Mrs. George gave the reading of Ordinance 17-3554 An Ordinance to Levy Special Assessments on Property for the Total Cost of Mitigating Noxious Weeds and High Grass Pursuant to Sections 91.70 - .73 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances and R.C. 715.261 and Declaring an Emergency. Mrs. George gave the reading of Ordinance 17-3556 An Ordinance Amending Section 94.05 of the Silverton Code of Ordinances to Allow for the Appropriate Imbibing of Alcoholic Beverages in Silverton Parks for Events Designated by Resolution of Council and Declaring an Emergency. Mrs. Thompson motioned for passage and was seconded by Mr. Wilson. A roll call vote was taken. All members present voted aye. Motion carried. Mrs. George gave the reading of Ordinance 17-3557 An Ordinance Authorizing the Village Manager to Enter into a Real Estate Contract to Purchase 6937 Montgomery Road and Declaring an Emergency. Mrs. George gave the reading of Ordinance 17-3558 An Ordinance Declaring Official Intent with Respect to Reimbursements of Temporary Advances made for Capital Expenditures for Land Acquisition in the Village of Silverton to be Made from Subsequent Borrowings and Declaring an Emergency. Mr. Quarry motioned for passage and was seconded by Mr. Wilson. A roll call vote was taken. All members present voted aye. Motion carried. Mrs. Thompson motioned to suspend the rules and was seconded by Mr. Wilson. A roll call vote was taken. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Mrs. George gave the reading of Resolution 17-760 A Resolution to Allow Beer and Wine Beverage Consumption at Ficke Fark on July 14, 2017 Between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. as part of the Village of Silverton's Summer Concert Series Events. Mr. Quarry motioned to amend the resolution to allow alcoholic beverage consumption between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on July 14, 2017 at Ficke Park. Mrs. Williams seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. All members present voted aye. Motion carried. Mr. Wilson motioned for passage of the amended resolution and was seconded by Mrs. Thompson. A roll call vote was taken. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Mrs. Thompson moved for adjournment and was seconded by Mr. Quarry. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote.
