ORDINANCE NO. 2024-11

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO SELL SURPLUS FURNITURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 13 of the Charter provides that "personal property may be sold as provided by ordinance;" and

WHEREAS, the Village determined that it should liquidate Village-owned furniture items, more fully described in the attached Exhibit A, because the items are no longer needed for public purposes and have no value, and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager is hereby authorized to take the necessary steps to sell the items using any means necessary and deposit any sale proceeds into the Village's General Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of Silverton, that:

SECTION I.

Village Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to sell the furniture items because they are no longer needed for public purposes and have no value and to deposit any of proceeds from its liquidation into the Village's General Fund.

SECTION II.

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to sell the furniture items.

SECTION III.

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Silverton; the reason for the emergency being the need to sell the surplus equipment and to collect the resulting revenue from such sale at the earliest possible time. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval.
