

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO TRADE-IN A UTILITY GOLF CART, AND TO APPLY THE TRADE-IN PROCEEDS TO PURCHASE A NEW JOHN DEERE GATOR CART FROM BUD HERBERT MOTORS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Article X, Section 13 of the Charter provides that "personal property may be sold as provided by ordinance"; and

WHEREAS: the Village has determined that it will trade in a 2005 Carry All 1 golf cart, Serial Number FG0550-580568, because it is no longer needed for public purposes, and to apply the trade-in proceeds toward purchasing a new John Deere Gator utility cart from Bud Herbert Motors, and

WHEREAS: the Village Manager is hereby authorized to take the necessary steps to liquidate the equipment using any means necessary and to apply such trade-in proceeds to purchase a new John Deere Gator cart from Bud Herbert Motors for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of Silverton, that:

SECTION I. Village Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to liquidate the equipment because it is no longer needed for municipal or public purposes, and to apply the proceeds or trade-in value toward the purchase of a new John Deere Gator.

SECTION III. The Village Manager shall perform all duties required by the Charter and Ordinances of the Village of Silverton, Ohio, relative to expenditures from the funds appropriated.

SECTION V. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Silverton; the reason for the emergency being the immediate need to make the purchase and utilize the equipment for the upcoming park activities. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.


