AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HAMILTON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES TO THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON

WHEREAS, The Hamilton County Sheriff and the Board of Hamilton County Commissioners are able to provide police services to the Village of Silverton; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Silverton and the Office of Hamilton County Sheriff Neil have successfully partnered to achieve high quality, cost-effective law enforcement in Silverton since August 1, 2014 through March 31, 2018, and the parties wish to continue this effective partnership moving forward; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement that will set forth the terms and policies governing the provision of police services; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of Silverton, that:

SECTION I.

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Hamilton

County Sheriff and the Board of County Commissioners setting forth the terms and

policies governing the provision of police services.

SECTION II.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval

at the earliest time provided by law.
