ORDINANCE NO. 21-3664

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO VACATE A PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR PROPERTY AT 6003 LILLIAN AVENUE OWNED BY CORNUCOPIA FAMILY HOMES, LLC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Cornucopia Family Homes, LLC presently owns 0.165 acres of land ("property") at 6003 Lillian Avenue at the southwest corner of Woodford Road and Lillian Avenue. The property is known by the County Auditor's Parcel Identification Number 602-0006-0238-00; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Silverton has an existing permanent stormwater easement bisecting the property at 6003 Lillian Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the reconstruction of Lillian Avenue provided the Village of Silverton the opportunity to install a new stormwater pipe entirely in the public right of way on Lillian and Woodford that will replace the existing stormwater infrastructure at 6003 Lillian Avenue, making the pipe and easement no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Village has completed the construction of the new stormwater pipe and thus desires to vacate its permanent easement on 6003 Lillian Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Silverton, that:

SECTION I. The Council of the Village of Silverton hereby vacates the permanent easement under the terms attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

SECTION II. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute the permanent easement and any related documents to effectuate such easement vacation.

SECTION III. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Silverton; the reason for the emergency being the immediate need to vacate the easement because it is no longer needed for municipal purposes and because doing so will facilitate the construction of a new single-family home at 6003 Lillian free and clear of the easement and enable the homebuilder to remove the obsolete stormwater pipe from the property at 6003 Lillian Avenue. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.


