## ORDINANCE NO. 23-3706

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION TO PROVIDE \$90,000 OF FUNDING FOR SILVERTON TOWN COMMONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Silverton has been awarded \$90,000 in funding from the State of Ohio through the State Capital Budget process as expressed through Senate Bill 310; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Silverton has budgeted additional funding to complete this project in the 2023 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement that will set forth the terms and policies governing the expenditure of SB 310 funding.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of Silverton, that:

SECTION I.

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission setting forth the terms and policies governing the expenditure of SB 310 funding for Silverton Town Commons.

**SECTION II.** 

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Silverton and its residents; the reason for the emergency being the need to enter into the agreement with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission for the expenditure for funding to enter into contract with the apparent low bidder to begin work as soon as possible and to complete all work before inclement weather later in the year. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
