

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-4**

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
TO TRADE IN A 1999 FORD F-550 AND A 2008 FORD F-150, AND TO APPLY THE TRADE-  
IN PROCEEDS TO PURCHASE A NEW FORD F-150 FROM LEBANON FORD  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Article X, Section 13 of the Charter provides that "personal property may be sold as provided by ordinance;" and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined that it should trade in two Village-owned vehicles: a 1999 Ford F-550 and a 2008 Ford F-150, more fully described in the attached Exhibit A (the "Vehicles") because they are no longer needed for public purposes and to apply their trade-in proceeds toward purchasing a new Ford F-150 from Lebanon Ford, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Manager is hereby authorized to take the necessary steps to liquidate the Vehicles using any means necessary and to apply such trade-in proceeds to purchase a new Ford F-150 from Lebanon Ford for municipal purposes.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village Council of Silverton, that:

**SECTION I.** Village Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to liquidate the Vehicles because they are no longer needed for municipal or public purposes and to apply the proceeds or trade-in value to purchase a new Ford F-150 for municipal purposes.


**SECTION II.** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to liquidate the Vehicles and to purchase a new Ford F-150 from Lebanon Ford for municipal purposes.

**SECTION III.** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Silverton; the reason for the emergency being the need to liquidate the Vehicles that are no longer needed for municipal or public purposes and to use the trade-in proceeds or value to purchase a new Ford F-150 for municipal purposes at the earliest possible time. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval.
