

RESOLUTION NO. 15-717

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR DEMOLITION SERVICES FOR VILLAGE-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 7319, 7434, AND 7446 MONTGOMERY ROAD TO BRUNK EXCAVATING, INC.

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.05, and Article X Section 8 of the Charter of the Village of Silverton, the Village of Silverton solicited and received bids for the demolition of three structures located at 7319, 7434, and 7446 Montgomery Road; and

WHEREAS: bids were publically opened and read on September 11, 2015 and the Village of Silverton received three bids prepared in accordance with the specifications in the Village's specifications; and

WHEREAS: Brunk Excavating, Inc. ("Contractor") is a qualified company to furnish labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the demolition of the structures, and Council has determined that Brunk Excavating, Inc. offers the best proposition for the municipality considering quality, service, adaptability to the requirements of the municipality and price to accomplish said Project; and

WHEREAS: Funds are available through Urban Land Assistance Program grant resources and in the Capital Improvement Fund for the completion of this work; and


WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Village Manager to enter into a contract with Brunk Excavating, Inc. to furnish labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the demolition of the Village-owned properties on Montgomery Road.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I. Council has determined that Brunk Excavating, Inc. offers the best proposition for the municipality considering quality, service, adaptability to the requirements of the municipality and price to accomplish said Project. Accordingly, the Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and subsequent change orders with Brunk Excavating, Inc. pursuant to the terms of the contract, which is on file in the administrative office of the Village of Silverton.

SECTION II. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


