RESOLUTION NO. 15-722

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO ADLETA CONSTRUCTION FOR THE VETERAN'S MEMORIAL AT SILVERTON PARK

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.05, and Article X Section 8 of the Charter of the Village of Silverton, the Village of Silverton solicited and received bids for installation of universally accessible playground equipment at Ficke Park as one of two projects planned this year to complete the renovation of Silverton's flagship green space; and

Article X, Section 8 of the Charter expressly provides that Council may award a contract to "the bidder WHEREAS: who in its judgment offers the best proposition for the municipality considering quality, service, adaptability to the requirements of the municipality and price, or may direct the rejection of all bids;"

WHEREAS: bids were publically opened and read on November 24, 2015 and the Village of Silverton received three bids prepared in accordance with the specifications in the Village's specifications; and

Adleta ("Contractor") is a qualified company to furnish labor, materials, and equipment necessary to WHEREAS: complete the installation of the Veterans Memorial at Silverton Park in accordance with bid specifications prepared by Kleingers, and in Council's estimation offers the best proposition for Silverton considering quality, service, adaptability to Silverton's requirements and price; and

Funds are available in the 2016 Budget through a Community Development Block Grant and a private donation for the completion of this work and Council desires to authorize a contract with Adleta to furnish labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project at Silverton Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Adleta pursuant to the terms of the contract, which is on file in the administrative office of the Village of Silverton. In Council's estimation, Adleta offers the best proposition for Silverton considering quality, service, adaptability to Silverton's requirements and price.

SECTION II.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
