

RESOLUTION NO. 16-735

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION WITH HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States has enacted the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 ("Act") which has as its primary objective the development of viable communities; and

WHEREAS: Hamilton County qualifies under said Act as an urban county eligible to receive federal block grant funding for support of community development activities; and

WHEREAS: Said Act provides for and encourages units of local government to enter into agreements of cooperation with urban counties for purposes of undertaking essential community development and housing assistance activities; and


WHEREAS: The Village of Silverton, Ohio desires to amend its cooperative agreement with Hamilton County for Federal Fiscal Years 2017 of the Community Development Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO:


SECTION I. That the Village Manager is hereby authorized to seek an amendment to Silverton's Cooperation Agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio to include Silverton's request for an additional \$75,000 of funding for streetscape improvements, \$65,000 for sanitary sewer upgrades near Meier's Wine Cellars, and \$100,000 for accessibility upgrades to a prospective new municipal building.

SECTION II. This Resolution shall be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




