## A RESOLUTION OF RECORD

## PURSUANT TO 153.015 OF THE SILVERTON CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INITIATE A TEXT AMENDMENT TO CONSIDER ALLOWING PRIVATE PARKING LOTS AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN THE C-1 NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS: the Village of Silverton regulates land uses through the Silverton Zoning Code to promote the public health, safety, convenience, comfort, prosperity and general welfare of the community by providing order and predictability to the ways in which land is used within Silverton; and

WHEREAS: the Zoning Code and Zoning Map may be changed from time to time pursuant to \$153.014 to \$153.017; and

WHEREAS: a proposed text amendment ordinance has been drafted for the Planning Commission to consider, to receive public comment on, and to recommend for amendment to Council if appropriate (attached hereto and made a part hereof). This draft ordinance, if adopted, would permit private parking lots as a conditional use, subject to approval by the Planning Commission, if the private parking lot supports redevelopment projects on nearby private property in the C-1 district of the Village of Silverton.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

This resolution of record shall serve as official intent of the Village Council to consider establishing \$153.092 (12) and amending \$153.177 (C) of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION II.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
