RESOLUTION NO. 21-829

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF LEVYING A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10-MILL LIMITATION EQUAL TO 5.0 RENEWAL MILLS AND REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Village Council anticipates levying a tax in excess of the 10-mill limitation as described herein; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined the need to renew the existing levy not exceeding 5.00 mills for the purpose of providing for current expenses; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, Village Council is required to certify to the County Auditor a Resolution requesting the County Auditor to certify certain matters in connection with such a levy;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION I.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary that a renewal tax be levied in excess of the 10-mill limitation upon the entire territory of the municipality for the benefit of the Village of Silverton for the purpose of current expenses of the subdivision, at a rate not exceeding 5.00 mills for each One Dollar of valuation which amounts to \$.50 for each dollar valuation for a period of four years which is a renewal of an existing 5.00 mill levy.

SECTION II.

The question of the passage of said renewal tax levy shall be submitted to the entire territory of the municipality at the Primary Election held on May 4, 2021. If approved by a majority of the electors voting at such election, said renewal tax levy shall first be placed upon the 2021 tax list and duplicate for first collection in the calendar year 2022.

SECTION III.

Pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the Village of Silverton and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills specified in Section I hereof, and the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify forthwith a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor at the earliest possible time so that the County Auditor may certify such matters in accordance with section 5705.03 to be able to appropriately consider, pass, and file a Resolution of necessity for consideration at the May 4, 2021 primary election.

SECTION IV.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
