A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS: the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) has created the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) whereby municipalities can apply for funds to undertake capital improvements; and

WHEREAS: the Village of Silverton desires to make improvements to various roadways and pursue funding through SCIP; and

WHEREAS: SCIP funds are available to help pay for improvements in a competitive grant and loan process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Silverton, that:

SECTION I. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to submit to the Ohio Public Works Commission an application for 2022 SCIP funds.

SECTION II. The Village Manager is further authorized to enter into a contract with the OPWC for SCIP funding should it be awarded to the Village of Silverton.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
