

RESOLUTION NO. 22-861

A RESOLUTION CREATING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE ONEOHIO SETTLEMENT MONIES AND DEFINING ITS USES

WHEREAS, the Silverton Village Council passed Resolution 2021-843 on August 5, 2021 accepting the material terms of the OneOhio Opioid Settlement; and

WHEREAS, OneOhio Funds must be utilized in a manner consistent with the “Approved Purposes” definition in the OneOhio memorandum of understanding (MOU); the Funds must be used for “evidence-based forward-looking strategies, programming and services used to (i) expand the availability of treatment for individuals affected by substance use disorders, (ii) develop, promote and provide evidence-based substance use prevention strategies, (iii) provide substance use avoidance and awareness education, (iv) decrease the oversupply of licit and illicit opioids, and (v) support recovery from addiction services performed by qualified and appropriately licensed providers[.]”; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) §5705.09(F) requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose.

WHEREAS, ORC §5705.10(I) states that money paid into a fund must be used only for the purposes for which such fund is established.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of Silverton, that:


SECTION I. All funds received from the OneOhio Settlement be expended **only** to cover costs of the Village consistent with the “Approved Purposes” definition in the OneOhio memorandum of understanding (MOU).

SECTION II. That in compliance with ORC §5705.09, that the Council of the Village of Silverton hereby directs the Village of Silverton Fiscal Officer take all necessary action to:

- (1) Create Special Revenue Fund 2918 – OneOhio Settlement Fund
- (2) Create revenue and appropriation accounts with restricted purpose
- (3) Provide any information related to any payments received to any governmental agency to which reporting is required.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time provided by law.


