

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-801**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION  
PROGRAM AND TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM  
FOR THE MONTGOMERY ROAD CORRIDOR PROJECT**

**WHEREAS:** the Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI) has solicited applications for funding through the Surface Transportation Program (STP) and the Transportation Alternatives (TA) programs; and

**WHEREAS:** the Village of Silverton is submitting an application for Surface Transportation Funds (STP) to the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments for the Montgomery Road Corridor Improvement Project, which has an estimated cost of \$4,778,100, the Village of Silverton hereby certifies the amount of \$955,620 of matching funds (20%) for the project, to be provided in the event such grant is received. The source of funding for the local share shall be the General Fund, and

**WHEREAS:** The Village of Silverton desires to make improvements to various roadways and pursue funding through STP and TA.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Silverton, that:**

**SECTION I.** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to submit to OKI an application for STP and TA funds.


**SECTION II.** The Village Manager is further authorized to enter into an agreement with OKI should funding be awarded to the Village of Silverton.




